Scope

University of South Carolina (USC) School of Medicine Columbia PA students.

Policy Statement

The Physician Assistant (PA) Program adheres to the University of South Carolina’s official policies governing the refund of academic tuition and fees. All determinations regarding refunds, including those related to course drops, withdrawals, changes in enrollment status, and term or rotation structures, are made in accordance with [USC Policy FINA 4.06: Refund of Academic Tuition and Fees](#).

Reason for Policy

This policy ensures that all PA Program students are informed of the refund rules and procedures that apply to their enrollment and that these rules are consistent with university-wide standards.

Policy Details

- Refunds for tuition and fees are processed solely according to the university’s established guidelines.
- The PA Program does not maintain a separate refund schedule or refund calculation process.
- Students are responsible for reviewing the full university policy to understand refund schedules, eligibility criteria, financial aid implications, and procedural requirements.
