

University of South Carolina Clinical Teaching Certificate Program Overview

The Clinical Teaching Certificate (CTC) program at the University of South Carolina College of Pharmacy is a structured educational program to enhance teaching and precepting skills, allowing pharmacists to become confident and motivational educators in both academic and clinical pharmacy settings. Two tracks are offered within the program: **Clinical Preceptor** and **Clinical Academician**.

The Clinical Preceptor track provides additional facilitation and recitation opportunities for individuals. This track is designed to benefit those interested in precepting pharmacy students. For individuals seeking to secure future academic positions or college-affiliated roles, the Clinical Academician track not only provides didactic opportunities but also fosters active involvement within the College of Pharmacy. Please note that there are specific requirements for each track. An activity with an asterisk (*) indicates distinctions between the Clinical Preceptor and Clinical Academician track.
